DC request for additional \$3500 to buy more lady bugs and Chrome books. Discussion with group as whole over where can reallocate money. Discuss Friends of Howard trust money, classroom improvement and teacher requests \$2,200, made more than projected in Fall Fete, Pizza Friday. TM says can be done with budget tweaks. DC motion to for \$3500 to add 5 extra projector combos, seconded KN, passed.

#### **Treasurer Update-TM**

Takes us through the budget- Fall Fete income exceed expectations- best yet, almost \$30,000

Division needed between Tech and Stem, can't lump them together.

Music Program- generates a surplus of \$3,000-\$10,000 Ms. Spademan is expecting about \$9,000 to be generated by her programs this year- leaving a surplus of about \$3.000
