

Audition FAQ's

Q: Do I have to memorize the script and music.

A: Yes, the music and your lines in the scene that you chose must be memorized.

Q: Can I audition for more than one part?

A: Yes, just let the director know you want to read for two parts.

Q: What if I don't want the part I'm offered?

A: You don't have to accept the role. Tell the director in your audition if there are any roles you do not want.

Q: Can I audition with a friend?

A: It's best if you audition by yourself, especially if you want a lead role, you need to be comfortable with the idea of being on stage by yourself. It can feel scary to audition, but the director will help you out. Don't worry.

Q: What if I'm in band or strings?

A: See information below on rehearsal schedule

Q: What if the role I want is not in the audition scripts?

A: Just choose a role that is the closest fit, and let the director know which role(s) you are interested in.

Q: How many casts will there be?

A: Most roles will be double cast, so one student will perform the role the first night, the other the second. On the night the student

is not doing their role, they will still be in the show performing in another aspect. It could be on stage chorus, it could be Cat skits or Cat commercials.

Q: Can I be in the stage crew and the cast

A: Unfortunately no, it is best to only have one stage crew for both nights.

Q: What if I don't know what role I want?

A: That is no problem, the director will be able to cast you based on your audition. But you still need to pick a role to memorize and audition with. The director needs to see that you can memorize a few lines and take direction. However, one idea is to watch the movie and think about what role would be most suited for you.

Q: Can I be in a skit and a cast member?

A: Yes

Q: Can I audition for a girl part and a boy part

A: Yes

Q: Do all roles have a singing part?

A: There are some roles without solo singing, but everybody sings together in a few places. The dogs and the geese only sing as a group. Kids doing Cat skits/commercials likely won't have a solo unless they want to.

Important Rehearsal Information:

There will be 2 to 3 rehearsals per week between Monday to Fridays 3:30-5pm beginning in January. Cast members will not be rehearsing every week, however they will be required 2-3 days a week when their scene is being rehearsed.

If you are in a lead role, you will be involved a greater number of weeks than a person in a minor role, but you will not be involved every week.

There is not a confirmed rehearsal schedule yet. It will be dependent on the scene being rehearsed that week and band/string schedules. We will do our best to accommodate

student schedules as well. We will schedule as far in advance as possible.

There are Mandatory rehearsals just before performance.
